Enclose details of such recipes, new and old, even if handwritten and containing butter stains, adding to their character. Importantly, recipes will **NOT** be tested as judging will be based on the album's presentation **only**.

Why not include photos, names and other items that might help tell the stories and add to the album's content and presentation. Importantly, where appropriate explain whom/what you are referring to, so anyone else reading your album in the future can easily put details into context.

Exhibit Criteria, Entry Details and Further Information

Two Options available in all the above Cookery classes

Class (a): Develop an album of no more than 20 pages (page size optional), using more professional materials such as those provided through companies like Vista Print, Photobox or similar (see their websites for examples).

Class (b): Develop an album of no more than 20 pages (page size optional) using either hand written and/or typed content and even using hints obtained through the website.

1st prize and ribbon will be awarded in Classes (a) and (b). 2nd & 3rd ribbons will also be awarded in each of above age groups.
