#### **PLEASE NOTE:**

Maximum number of entries per exhibitor is TWO. All must be labelled with artist name, price and contact phone. Works can be for sale at 10% commission. Payment for sold works will only be by bank transfer after the show from the Victor Harbor Art Society. Labels for art will be provided. Multiple images must be contained within one frame. Art created at workshops should not be entered. Maximum size shall not exceed 1 meter square. Photography or 3Dimensional work is not accepted.

Note there is a **Junior Art Section** in this show book. Use the Indoor Exhibit Entry form and deliver to that pavilion.

**COLLECTION:** Must be between 4 and 5pm on Sunday October 12th 2025 at the Higgins Pavilion.

All art will be judged and ribbons and certificates issued. The Rex Fagg 'Best in Show' and The People's Choice Award will be awarded a monetary prize from The Victor Harbor Art Society.
