Entries close last mail Friday, September 18th 2026.

No entry fee.

Please enter using the entry form on page 25 and post to Sue Thomas, Indoor Co-ordinator, Port Elliot Show, PO Box 399, Victor Harbor 5211 or drop into the collection box at the Secretary's Office at the Port Elliot Showground **by no later than 5pm Friday, September 18th, 2026.**

Conditions of Entry for Indoor Pavilion - Any previous first prize winning exhibit from the Port Elliot Show is not eligible to be entered into any future Port Elliot Shows.

Restriction of Entries:

- One entry per exhibitor per class, except for Craft, Needlework where a maximum of 3 entries may be accepted.
- Woodwork - Open classes a maximum of 3 entries may be accepted and Woodwork - Junior 1 entry per person per class is allowed.
- All Indoor Sections only open to amateur and exhibits must be the work of the exhibitor.

Delivery

For **Cookery, Cut Flowers/Pot Plants, Floral Art, Home Produce, Scarecrows/Decorated Bikes** can ONLY be delivered to the O'BRIEN Pavilion Port Elliot Show Grounds between 8.30am and 11.30am on Friday, October 9th, 2026.

Needlework can ONLY be delivered to the O'Brien Pavilion Thursday October 8th between 3pm - 6pm.

Craft can ONLY be delivered to the O'Brien Pavilion Thursday October 8th between 3pm - 6pm.

Junior Art ONLY can be delivered to the BASHAM Pavilion on Friday 9th October 2026 between 8.30am and 11.30am.

Woodwork can ONLY be delivered to the MICHAEL SCOTT Pavilion between 8.30am & 12.00 noon on Friday, October 9th, 2026.

- Any entries delivered after the closing time will not be accepted for judging.
- Exhibit cards which will be posted to you are to be firmly attached to the exhibit.
- Please also tear off the top receipt as this is required to collect exhibits on Sunday.
- Junior sections are for 16 years and under as at the 1st November in each show year.
- Junior Classes 1st, 2nd, & 3rd cash, prizes and ribbons awarded (**cash prizes - 1st \$5, 2nd \$3, 3rd \$1**) The value of actual prizes will vary depending on the level of sponsorship received for the individual sections
- Open classes 1st, 2nd & 3rd place ribbons awarded.
- Please only use paper plates or cardboard for presentation. **NO single use plastic plates are to be used.**
- Special awards and prizes will be awarded where indicated in all age categories and sections.

The O'Brien, Basham & Scott Pavilions will be closed to the public at 3.45pm on Sunday, October 11th to allow preparation time for collection of exhibits at 4pm. Exhibits MUST only be collected between 4 and 5pm Sunday, October 11th. If not collected, items will only be held until 5.30pm at the latest.



Please DO NOT present your items on single-use plastic plates. Use paper or cardboard plates instead.

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
